If it turns out like the development at the Battle of Bosworth site, it will be a good plan. It doesn't matter if it will take a few years to complete, it's got to be taken carefully



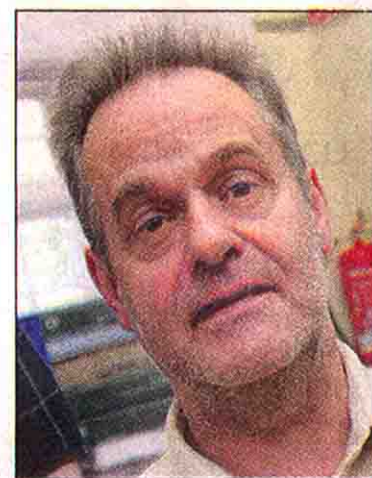
TONY BOULLEMIER, aged 60, retired from Boughton
